





His dam 88J is an ELITE female with 10 calves having a 107 weaning ratio.







While some preffer to charge forward using highly promoted unknown bulls, we really like progressing by going back and using some of these old highly proven bulls like Pine Drive. The 055 cow produced until she was 14 including sons to Jubilee, McCrimmon, Mueller, Van De Five, Werenka, and a \$4200 son to Verbeeks'.

In 2009 our kids pooled their resources and purchased a Black Simmental bull from Barclay Smith. We showed against him as a calf and in fact he was the Supreme





Champion Bull at Mayerthorpe Fair. They bought him to breed their commercial cows but I couldn't resist trying to raise a few good hybrid bulls as well. I think this 56 is pretty darn good. If you have kids in 4-H I think they'd be better showing this guys sons than showing against them!





Maternal brothers include a \$4500 bull to Abraham land & Cattle, \$4600 to Blaine Dunlop, \$3000 to L4L Ranches and another to Ben & Hendria Hospers.
